

#### Warning (Important Safeguards)

You must read the following notices carefully before using the product:

- This product should only be installed to the rear of the back of the driver's seat where it will not be visible, directly or indirectly, to the operator of the motor vehicle.
- Don't operate the monitor while driving. It is unlawful in most jurisdictions.
- Don't open or disassemble the product. It may cause electric shock.


#### Caution

- Don't attempt to service this product yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.
- Do not expose extreme hot and humid temperature. (Safe storage environment: -20<<60 degrees Celsius and <90% humidity.
- Do not press the surface of the screen, it may cause a permanent damage.
- Do not spray liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners directly on the device (including abrasive cleaners, waxes, and solvents.). Wet a cloth with a neutral detergent (e.g.clean water), squeeze it tight and then gently wipe the outer surfaces of the monitor with it
- Do not compel to flip down by force. It may cause breakage of the product.
- When you replace dome lights bulb, you must use a 3 watt bulb, if you use a more than 3 watt bulb, housing could be melted.





## TROUBLESHOOTING

Symptom	Cause	Possible Solution
No Response To Remote Control.	<ul> <li>Batteries in remote control are missing, dead or incorrectly placed.</li> <li>Improper direction of remote control to the sensor.</li> </ul>	<ul><li>Replace batteries.</li><li>Point the remote control unit to the sensor.</li></ul>
No power to unit	- Power supply is not connected or Power connection fuse blown	Check connections or Replace fuse.
No picture & sound	<ul> <li>Improper selection of video source.</li> <li>A/V source connection is wrong.</li> </ul>	- Switch video source.  - Check the A/V source connection.
Noise on screen	- Both Video sources are on,	- Turn off one of video source.
