

FEATURES

Do not play.	The disc is dirty or damaged.
The disc is out automatically.	The temperature is out of operating temperature.
The disc can not go out.	Push the disc when press EJECT button. A disc is loaded in the mechanism. Press RESET button.
Function button is unworkable.	Press RESET button.
There's audio skipping.	The disc is dirty or damaged.
No picture.	Open TV. Choose video input on the TV to receive The picture from the unit.
Picture stops (pauses).	The disc is dirty or damaged. Color system setup is incorrect. Adjust to PAL or NTSC according to the TV.



Replacing the batteries





UNIT INSTALLATION


Installation Method 1: Din Front-Mount

Install the Mounting Box into the dashboard.



Method 2≫

Select a position where the screw holes of the Mounting bracket supply with the car and the screw holes of the main unit become aligned, tighten the screws on each side then fasten them to car.

Handling and Cleaning >>

- Dirty, dusty, scratched or warped discs may not play properly.
- Do not place stickers or make scratches on discs
- Do not warp discs.
- Store discs in their cases when not in use.
- Do not place discs in the following places:
 - 1. Direct sunlight.
 - 2. Dirty, dusty and damp areas.
 - 3. High temperature places.
 - 4. On the sets or dashboard.

Disc Cleaning >>

Use a dry soft cloth to wipe the surface. If the disc is quite dirty, use a soft cloth slightly moist with isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol.

Never use solvent such as benzene, thinner or conventional record cleaners which may mar the surface of the disc.



A disc may became somewhat scratched (although not enough to made it unusable) depending on your handing it in the condition of the usage environment. These scratches are not an indication of any problem with the player.



DVD SETUP MENU

SETUP MENU OPERATION

Press the [SETUP] button of Remote Control to enter the SETUP Menu.

Press the [<] / [>] buttons to switch the main menus as following:

SYSTEM LANGUAGE AUDIO VIDEO SPEAKER DIGITAL

Press the $\lceil \land \rceil / \lceil \lor \rceil$ button to enter the submenus from main menus.

Press the $\lceil \land \rceil$ button on the top submenu or press the $\lceil \lor \rceil$ button on the bottom of submenu to exit the submenus to main menus.

Press the $[\land]/[\lor]$ buttons to select the submenus as your need.

Press the [>] button to enter the items of submenus.

Press the [<] button to exit the items of submenus.

Press the $\lceil \vee \rceil / \lceil \wedge \rceil$ buttons to select the item you want to change.

Press the [ENTER] button to confirm the item you have selected.

Press the [SETUP] button or press the [ENTER] button on the submenu

"EXIT SETUP" to exit the SETUP Menu and save all settings.

DISC OPERATION



Press the button to play any track of random. Press it again to return to normal playing. It takes no effect as DVD, VCD(PBC ON).

SLOW >>

Press the button to slow forward. It takes effect as DVD disc.

PROGRAM ≫

When playing VCD(PBC OFF), press STOP button then PROGRAM button to enter the program menu. It takes no effect as DVD disc.

$A-B \gg$

Press the button to make the disc repeated between point A and point B. Press the button once to select point A and press again to select point B. Then the unit will repeat the content between A and B. To make the disc played normally, just press A-B button the third time. It takes no effect as VCD (PBC On) or MP3/WMA.

TITLE >>

Press the button to title menu when playing DVD disc.

AUDIO >>

Press the button to select the audio channel.

Repairing New Discs with Rough Spots >>>

A new disc may have rough edges on its inside and outside edges. If a disc with rough edges is used, the proper setting will not be performed and the player will not play the disc. Therefore, remove the rough edges in advance by using a ballpoint pen or pencil. To remove the rough edges, press the side of the pen or pencil against the inside and outside edges of the disc.

BASIC OPERATIONS



If you want to play a disc, firstly you should push POWER button to turn on the set. Place the disc into the set and the unit will automatically start to play.

RESET ≫

Press this button to reset the unit system. If you want to use the unit after reset it, you should press POWER button again.

MUTE ≫

Press this button to mute sound. Press it again to cancel this function.

VOLUME ADJUSTMENT >>

Press VOL+/VOL- button to adjust sound volume.

PLAYING DISC >>

Insert a disc into the Disc Loading Slot, the unit will automatically switch on. If a disc is loaded, the unit starts playing.

EJECT ≫

Press this button to eject or load the disc. At the abnormal situation, press the EJECT button for seconds to eject the disc.

PLAY/PAUSE >>

Press the button to play a disc or to make it pause.

STOP >>

During playing, press the button one time, the DVD player memorizes the location where you stopped (press PLAY button to resume playing from the memorized point); Press the button again to stop playing (press PLAY button to start playing from the beginning of the disc).

FAST REVERSE/FAST FORWARD >>

Press the button to select fast reverse/fast forward and speed.

DISPLAY >>

Press this button to display the current playback information on the screen. When play DVD, you can select title, chapter, time, audio, subtitle, angle, sound in turn by pressing direction buttons and pressing enter button to confirm. When play VCD, you can select track(PBC OFF)/PBC(PBC ON), time, audio, sound in turn by pressing direction buttons and pressing enter button to confirm.



ZOOM ≫

Press the zoom button during normal playback to zoom a picture. Press this button repeatedly to change the magnification levels.

REPEAT ≫

When playing DVD disc, press the button to repeat the title or chapter; When playing VCD(PBC OFF)/CD/MP3 /WMA Disc, press the button to repeat one track or all tracks.

SETUP >>

Press this button to enter setup menu.

ANGLE >>

Press Angle button to select different filming angles stored on the DVD media during playback. It takes effect as some angles stored DVD disc.

PBC ≫

Press this button to select PBC on or off during playing VCD disc. When PBC on, the screen display the menu, you can choose any track; when PBC OFF, it starts to play the disc in order.

MENU ≫

Press this button to return boot menu during playing DVD disc. When VCD disc in, it is the same as PBC function.

NUMBER BUTTON ≫

Push the buttons to play your favorite track. If the track is from 1 to 9, you can directly press the number. If the track number is more than 9, you can press number buttons in sequence to select the track. When DVD disc in or VCD disc (PBC ON) in, press PBC/MENU to root menu then select the track.

DIRECTION BUTTON AND ENTER BUTTON ≫

Press the DIRECTION button to move the cursor to the select item, and then press the ENTER button to confirm it.

PREVIOUS/NEXT >>

When playing DVD/ CD/ MP3 /WMA disc, press PREVIOUS/NEXT to select the previous/next chapter or track. If the playing chapter, song or track have played over 3 seconds, press PREVIOUS button, it will come back to the same chapter, song or track, you should press PREVIOUS button two times to the previous one.

$P/N \gg$

Press the button to select video output (PAL/NTSC/AUTO). When DVD/VCD disc in, press STOP button then select the video output. When MP3/CD/WMA disc in, it takes effect of P/N button unless eject the disc.
