





## 2. System Connection Diagram


Place the system on a firm and level surface. Its speaker drivers are shielded, which limits the possibility of video interference if it is placed near a computer or video screen.







## 3. Function key of product and how to connect

- 15) Wall mount bracket









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
## 4. Display state sketch map








CD state




**DVD** state

## 5. Function key of Remote control

- 1) Stand by button
- 2) Mute button
- 3) Select input DVD audio signal
- 4) Select input CD audio signal

- 9) Treble volume up

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#### 6. Remote control operation instruction

Your system is ready to go as soon as you plug it in, turn it on. Simply press the Stand-By button to active your system.

#### 1. SOURCE CONTROL

The system has 4 audio input mode:

A.CD in B: PC in C: TV in D: AUX in

The default mode is set to CD in. Press the Source Select button to select the audio signal input source among them.

When 3.5mm connector plug in AUX jack, the Input Mode automatically change to AUX Mode. It will be back to the original mode when you plug AUX out.

#### 2. SOUND CONTROL

Press the button Volume Up/Down to adjust the system volume.

#### 3. SURROUND CONTROL

Press Surround button, you can enjoy the virtual surround experience from the system. Then press Stereo button, you can adjust the surround sound field effect Press By-Pass button, it is back to bypass mode, surround effect off.

#### 4. PLAYING CONTROL


- 1, In DVD mode, the text "DD" is shown on the display screen. You can adjust volume, tone, surround effect etc.
- 2, In CD mode, the text "CD" is shown on the display screen. You can adjust volume, tone, surround effect etc.
- 3, In TV mode, the text "TV" is shown on the display screen. You can adjust volume, tone, surround effect etc.

## 7. Maintaining the system

Changing the remote control battery is the only regular maintenance that is required. You may also clean the system as needed.

## Battery replacement

- Replace the remote control battery when it stops operating (normally every year or two), or its range seems reduced.
- Keep in mind that lighting and other room conditions, in addition to battery age, can affect the operating range of an infrared remote control.



## To clean the system

Wipe the system using a soft dry cloth. You can also lightly vacuum the grille.

- Do not use solvents, chemicals, or sprays.
- Do not allow liquids to spill or objects to drop into any openings.

## 8. Troubleshooting

Problem	What to do
No sound	<ul> <li>Make sure the system is plugged in, Press the Play/Pause button on the remote control.</li> <li>Make sure your music source is turned on, and a music track is selected and playing.</li> <li>Increase the volume setting for the system.</li> </ul>
No display wall outlet	Make sure the power cable is securely plugged into a functioning
Sound too low	<ul> <li>Increase the volume setting for the system</li> <li>Increase the volume setting for the music source</li> </ul>
Your system does not respond to its remote commands:	<ul> <li>Unplug the power cable for 1 minute, then plug it back in. This resets the system.</li> <li>Contact F&amp;B Customer Service about the problem.</li> </ul>
