## **Batteries Replacement**

If the range of the operation of the car remote control becomes short or no function while operating, replace the batteries with a new button cell. Make sure the batteries polarity before replace.

- Gently pull out the batteries holder while pressing the stopper ①.
- Put the button-type batteries with make (+) upward into the batteries holder.
- Insert the batteries holder into the remote control.







#### Installation Method 1: Din Front-Mount






Install the screw holes at the sides of the unit.

- Remove the hooks on both sides.
- 2. Select a position where the screw holes of the mounting bracket supply with the car and the screw holes of the main unit become aligned (are fitted), tighten the screws (see 4 at 2 places) on each side, and fasten them to car.





#### Detach the Unit

- 1. Detach the front panel.
- 2. Insert the key that supply to the unit at both sides of the unit (shown as illustrated) until pull the key out to make it possible to remove the unit from the dashboard.



## WIRE CONNECTION



### NOTE:

- If you want to control the set in another place, you can insert the remote control receiver in the rear panel.
- You can input external AV signal through connecting AV input 1 (Front Panel).
- 3. You can connect 2 monitors with video output 1 and video output 2.
- If you directly connect Audio Output (FRONT LEFT, FRONT RIGHT) to TV, SETTING Down mix MENU as STEREO.

**DISC NOTES** 

Disc formats supported by this player


- Handling and Cleaning
- Dirty, dusty, scratched and warped discs will unworkable.
- Do not place stickers or make scratches on discs
- Do not warp discs.
- A disc should always be kept in its case to prevent from damage while nonuse.
- Do not place discs in the following places:
  - Direct sunlight.
  - 2. Dirty, dusty and damp areas.
  - Near car neaters.
  - 4. On the sets or dashboard.

## Disc Cleaning

Use a dry soft cloth to wipe the surface. If the disc is quite dirty, use soft cloth slightly moist with isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol. Never use solvents such as benzene, thinner or conventional record cleaners which may mar the surface of the disc.

#### Note:

A disc may became somewhat scratched (although not enough to made it unusable) depending on your handing in the usage environment. These scratches are not an indication of any problem with the player.





## Repairing New Discs with Rough Spots

A new disc may have rough edges on its inside and outside edges. If a disc with rough edges is used, the proper setting will not be performed and the player will not play the disc. Therefore, remove the rough edges in advance by using a ballpoint pen or pencil.

To remove the rough edges, press the side of the pen or pencil against the inside and outside edges of the disc.

## BASIC OPERATIONS

#### PREPARATION

If you want to play a disc, firstly you should push POWER button to turn on the set and confirm DVD LED on. Place the disc into the set and start to play. If you want to use external input, firstly you should push POWER button to turn on the set and push SOURCE button to select external input 1 or external input 2. You can confirm it through seeing the LED on panel. Then you should connect signal cable. The function is to let signal through without control.

#### MODE

Press this button to select the display mode: DVD/external input 1/external 2.

#### PLAY/PAUSE

Press the button to play a disc or to make the disc pause.

#### **EJECT**

Press this button to open or close a disc.

### STOP

During playing, press the button one time, the DVD player memorizes the location where you stopped ( press PLAY button to resume playing from the memorized point); Press the button again to stop playing (press PLAY button to start playing from the beginning of the disc.)

When playing other disc, press the button to stop playback (press PLAY button to start playing from the beginning of the disc).

#### NUMBER BUTTON

Push the buttons to play your favorite track. If the track is from 1 to 9, you can directly press the number button. If the track number is 10 and over, you should use button 10+ and the other number buttons together to select the track.

## DIRECTION BUTTON AND ENTER BUTTON

Press the DIRECTION button to move the cursor to the select item, and then press the ENTER button to confirm it.

#### FF/FR

Press the button to select fast/ reverse forward and speed.

#### ZOOM

Press the zoom button during normal playback to zoom a picture, Press this button repeatedly to change the magnification levels.

## REPEAT

When playing DVD disc, press the button to repeat the title or chapter. When playing VCD or CD disc, press the button to repeat one track. When playing MP3, press the button to repeat folder, all discs or a song.

### A/B

Press the button to set up the repeat playing between A and B

tracks. Press once to set up the A track, press twice to set up the B track, than the disc will be playing between A and B tracks.

#### **GOTO**

When playing VCD disc or CD disc, press the button to select play according to time.

When playing DVD disc, press the button to select play according to title or chapter.

#### **AUDIO**

During playing a DVD disc, press the button to select audio type. During playing other disc, press the button to select audio channel.

#### PAL/NTSC

Press the button to select video output (PAL/NTSC).

### DISPLAY

Press this button to display the current playback information on the screen.

### VOL+/VOL-

Press the button to adjust sound volume.

### MUTE

Press this button to mute sound.

#### SETUP

Press this button to enter setup menu.

#### PREVIOUS/NEXT

When playing a DVD disc, press PREVIOUS to select the previous chapter Press NEXT to select the next chapter.

When playing a MP3 disc, press PREVIOUS to select the previous

song, press NEXT to select the next song.

When playing CD or VCD disc, press PREVIOUS to select the previous track, press NEXT to select the next track.

#### TITLE

For DVD discs, press this button to enter the title menu, press the DIRECTION buttons and PLAY button to select and play (only f supported by the discs.)

#### PBC

Press this button to return boot menu during playing VCD disc.

#### MENU/ADD DEL

Press this button to return boot menu during playing DVD disc.

Use this function to delete or memorize the channel you want. Select a channel which you want by pressing the number button and add or erase the channel by pressing the ADD/DEL button.

### SUBTITLE

Fro DVD disc, press this button to select subtitle.

### RESET

Press this button to reset the set system. If you want to use the set, you should press POWER button again.

### ANGLE

This button is to allow the user to select from different filming angles stored on the DVD media during playback.

## SETUP OF FUNTION

### 1. DVD PLAYER SYSTEM DESCRIPTION

### SETUP MENU DESCRIPTION

This menu can be used to choose audio language, subtitle language, OSD language and DVD menu language. You need to \$\epsilon \textstyle{\textstyle{1}} \text{up these items} when you begin to play a DVD disc. When you start to play a DVD disc, the DVD player will automatically choose default language if the DVD player contains this language already.

- You can press SETUP button on the remote control to bring this setup menu.
- Use UP/DOWN arrow buttons to select the item that you want to change.
- Use LEFT/RIGHT arrow buttons to change your setting.
- Use UP/DOWN arrow buttons to exit the item you want.
- Use UP/DOWN arrow button to page icon and highlight it. Use LEFT/RIGHT arrow buttons to change setup menu page.
- After finishing your setting, you can choose SETUP to exit and save these modifications into memory.

### SYSTEM MENU

### **OSD LANGUAGE**

This item is used to select OSD (On-screen Display) language. It includes:

• English

### SCREEN SAVER


This item is used to open/close SCREEN Saver.

- Open: Screen Saver will automatically be executed if the screen keeps quiet for whole fifteen minutes.
- Close: Screen Saver would not be executed in any situation.

### LOAD DEFAULT

This item is used to restore all menus as manufacture's defaults, except the item related to Parent Control Sub-tem.

## VIDEO SETUP MENU

#### TV SCREEN

Which picture format appears on your TV depends on the kind of TV you have and the picture mode you TV set to:

- 4:3: LETTER BOX refers to pictures where black bands appear at the top and bottom.
- 16:9: WIDE SCREEN for wide screen TV(Full Mode)

#### TV OUTPUT

This item is used to select a TV Signal system to match you TV set. It includes:

- AUTO
- NTSC
- PAL

#### BRIGHTNESS

This item is used to adjust the BRIGHTNESS to your screen

- Press ENTER button to enter this item
- Press LEFT/RIGHT arrow buttons to adjust brightness
- Press UP/DOWN arrow buttons to exit

### CONTRAST

This item is used to adjust the CONTRAST to your screen

- Press ENTER button to enter this item
- Press LEFT/RIGHT arrow buttons to adjust contrast
- Press UP/DOWN arrow buttons to exit



#### CHANNEL

2CH STEREO: Select stereo

2CH LT/RT: Select left and right channel

#### DIGITAL OUTPUT

 SET: Each DVD disc has its own Audio Out put options. You can set up the DVD's Digital Audio Output according to your speaker system. This item contains:

DOLBY: Select LPCM and BITSTREAM output and OFF.

DTS: Select LPCM and BITSTREAM OUTPUT and OFF.

MPEG: Select LPCM and BITSTREAM output and OFF.

PCM: Select LPCM 48KHZ and LPCM 96KHZ output.


DIGITAL OUTPUT: Turn digital output ON and OFF.

HDCD UPSAMPLE: Turn HDCD up sample ON and OFF.

SECURITY SETUP



(SECURITY SETUP MENU)

#### PARENTAL CONTROL

The Parental Control is a rating system such as movie ratings. This helps you control the types of DVDs that your family watches. For example, you could edit out violent scenes that are unsuitable for children.

- Use UP/DOWN arrow buttons to select Password item, and enter a personal 4-digital right security code.
- Use UP/DOWN arrow buttons to select Parent Control, and Use LEFT/RIGHT arrow buttons to select the parental control level.
- Press UP/DOWN arrow buttons to exit.

You can not play DVD discs rated higher than level you selected unless you cancel the parental control function.

Note: This feature works with DVD discs that have been assigned a rating.

#### CHANGING PARENTAL CONTROL PASSWORD

Use UP/DOWN arrow buffons to select Password item.


- Enter old 4-digital security code
- Then enter new 4-digital security code
- Re-enter to confirm you 4-digital security code.
- Press UP/DOWN arrow button to exit.

**Note**: New 4-digital security code will take effect after closing the Setup Menu.

#### NOTE:

- 1. It is necessary to stop the disc playing if you want to enter the PREFERENCES MENU ITEM.
- 2. In PREFERENCES MENUU ITEM, the system default password is 0000.

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Do not use and store the loader in dusty, high temperature and high humidity environments.
- Do ground all equipments and works in order to avoid causing damage of the loader by electrostatic discharges.
- The user who handles this product takes all the necessary precautions to avoid ESD (Electro-Static Discharge) failures.
- 4) Do not touch assembled PCB with hand directly, and avoid fingerprints or stains remains on he PCB and handle the loader in a clean environment
- 5) Do not shock loader during handing and manufacturing
- 6) Do not use loader immediately when you bring it from cold to warm place. Great change of temperature may cause moisture condensing on the pickup lens, which influence the readability for certain time. Please make the loader stable at least 2 hours before operating under such a condition.
- Do not disassemble the loader to avoid ESD failures and to prevent from contamination.

## REPLACE THE FUSE

Make sure the amperage match the specified when replacing the fuses. If the fuse is blown, check the power connection and replace a new one. Of the same problem occurs, it would be subjected to the malfunction in-house. In such cases, please consult the nearest service dealer.

### A Warning

Never use the fuse with the rated amperage more than that supplied to your unit, otherwise it will damage the unit.

## TROUBLE SHOOTING

SYMPTOM	CAUSE/SOLUTION
No sounds.	Cancel the mute function. Adjust the volume.
The memory contents are vanished.	Disconnect the power wire or battery. Press RESET button.
Do not play.	The disc is dirty or damaged.
The disc is out automatically.	The temperature is out of operating temperature
The disc can not go out.	Push the disc while pressing EJECT button. A disc is loaded in the mechanism. Press RESET button.
Function button is unworkable.	Press RESET button.
There's audio skipping.	The disc is dirty or damaged.
No picture.	Open TV. Choose video input on the TV to Receive the picture from the unit.
Picture stops (pauses).	The disc is dirty or damaged. Color system setup is incorrect, Adjust to be PAL or NTSC according to the TV

If any of problem persists after checking the above list. Please consult your nearest service dealer. Never attempt to disassemble the unit personally.
