
Replacing the batteries

If the remote control has no function or if the operating range reduces, replace the old battery with new one.


 Pull out the battery holder. Follow the arrow (1) slide the tab to the right while pulling the holder awat at the same time.



2. Place the new battery. In the tray and slide back into the remote.




3. Make sure the holder locks into place.




UNIT INSTALLATION

Installation Method 1: Din Front-Mount


Install the Mounting sleeve into the dashboard.




Bend as many claws outward for tight fit, to lock the sleeve into place.



Install the trim bezei to the unit. (Arched surface toward, the bottom).



Use the Rear Mounting Bolt to support the unit,





Installation Method 2:

Using the screw holes at the sides of the unit. (ISO Mount).

- 1. Remove the hooks on both sides.
- Select a position where the screw holes of the mounting bracket supplied with the car and the screw holes of the main unit become aligned, tighten the screws on each side, and re-mount the brackets with the factory hardware in the original location.







UNIT REMOVAL (when installed using the sleeve)

- 1. Detach the front panel.
- Insert the keys supplied with the unit on both sides

 (as illustrated) as this will release the internal locks so you can slide the
 unit out.

Handling and Cleaning

- Dirty, dusty, scratched or warped discs may not play properly.
- Do not place stickers or make scratches on discs
- Do not warp discs.
- Store discs in their cases when not in use.
- Do not place discs in the following places:
 - Direct sunlight.
 - 2. Dirty, dusty and damp areas.
 - 3. High temperature places.
 - 4. On the sets or dashboard.

Disc Cleaning

Use a dry soft cloth to wipe the surface. If the disc is quite dirty, use a soft cloth slightly moist with isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol. Never use solvent such as benzene, thinner or conventional record cleaners which may mar the surface of the disc.

Note: A disc may become somewhat scratched to a point which will skip excessively or not play at all in your player. Have the disc resurfaced or polished to reduce the issue or replace the disc with a new one.

Repairing New Discs with Rough Spots

A new disc may have rough edges on its inside and outside edges. If a disc with rough edges is used, the proper setting will not be performed and the player will not play the disc. Therefore, remove the rough edges in advance by using a ballpoint pen or pencil. To remove the rough edges, press the side of the pen or pencil against the inside and outside edges of the disc.

BASIC OPERATIONS

Power:

Press the POWER button to turn the unit ON or press the same button to turn the unit OFF.

Switching sources:

When the unit in turned ON, Pressing the POWER button will toggle between modes.

Mute:

Press the MUTE/LOUD button to attenuate the audio, Press it again or any volume key andresume to the previous level.

Loud:

Press and hold the MUTE/LOUD button to activate loudness feature.

Volume Contorl:

Press VOL+ button to increase the sound level and VOL- to decrease the sound level.

Press EQ/SEL button to enter the sound setup page;

In DVD or any AV mode, Press the EQ/SEL button twice to enter the monitors color setup dialog.

Note: Select "RESET" item. press "LEFT/RIGHT" direction button to restore the default device.



In the RADIO mode, press the EQ/SEL button to enter the tuners' setup dialog. This tuner can be switched to work in other countries, choose the one that works best for you.

NOTE: Area can be choosed as follows: USA-JAPAN-OIRT-EUROPE-ASIA

SEL:


Press and hold the EQ/SEL button to access the preset EQ settings or the user settings to adjust the audio to your preference.

If the unit ever needs to be reset, you can do so by removing the face plate to gain access to the reset button. Press and hold this button to switch back to all the original factory settings. Keep in mind this will erase all of you preset radio stations and any EQ settigns you may have made and saved.

Viewing Angel Adjustment:

Press and hold the OPEN button to adjust the angel of the face to your oreference.

Angel 1- Angel 2- Angel 3- Angel 4- Angel 1



NOTE: You can also make these same adjustment from your remote control, simply press and hold the EJECT button to adjust to your preference.

Restore Default Angel Device


Start by powering OFF your unit, then press preset buttons 1-6 and power the unit back ON. The monitor should display "OTOR ALGN OK" Press the OPEN button and insert a CD. The motor and gear drives are nowback to their factory positions.



DVD/VCD/CD/MP3 OPERATIONS

Playing disc

Press OPEN button, the front panel will slide down to Position 1; then insert a disc into the Disc Loading Slot; the panel will slide back automatically.



Ejecting a Disc

Press OPEN button, the front panel will slide down to Position 1; then eject a disc; the panel will slide back, automatically or after one minute if no action is taken.

NOTE: The "EJECT" button on the remate control will perform the same functions.

Play/Pause

Press PLAY/PAUSE button to play or pause the disc.

Stop

During movie playback, press STOP button one time, the DVD player memorizes the location where you stopped (press PLAY button to resume playing from the memorized point); Press Stop (press PLAY button to start playing from the beginning of the disc). Twice to not memorize the last position.

F.FWD/F.REV

Press F.FWD/F.REV button to select fast/reverse forward search. Press F.FWD/ F.REV on the remote control performs the same operation. Press PLAY/PAUSE button to resume to normal play.

Previous/Next

Press Previous/Next button to go to the PRÉVIOUS/NEXT chapter , track or song.

Setup

Press SETUP button to enter setup menu-

Enter

In DVD mode, press ENTER button to confirm the Setup Menu.

Direction

UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT ($\triangle/ + / + / +)$; press the Oirection buttons to move the cursor to the selected item.

Display

Press Display button to show current playback information on the screen.

Zoom

Press Zoom button during normal playback to zoom a picture. Press it repeatedly to change the magnification levels.

Repeat

Press the repeat button to repeat the same track, press it twice to repeat all tracks. When playing a DVD movie, pressing one will repeat the same chapter but pressing twice will repeat the entire title.

Angle

Press Angle button to select different viewing angles with interactive DVD media during playback.

PBC

PBC is available in VCD mode as playback control switch.

Menu

Menu is available in DVD mode as playback control panel.

Audio

When playing a DVD disc , press Audio button to select other available language .

Subtitle

For DVD disc, press Subtitle button to select available subtitle language.

Program

When playing VCD disc(PCB off) or CD disc, press Program button enter program status, press the number buttons to enter the track number you want to playback. If you want to exit, press the PROGRAM button again.

Slow

Press the SLOW button to activate slow motion playback(DVD mode only).

P/N

Press P/N button to select video output format(PAL/NTSC).

Number Buttons

Push Number Buttons to play your favorite track.

For example:

Track 8, press number button "8":
Track 68, press number button "6" "8":

Track 168, press number button "6" "6" "8".

Random

Press RDM button to shuffle all tracks. Press it again to return to normal play back from the first track(CD mode only).

RADIO OPERATIONS

Band Selector:

In the RADIO mode, press BAND button to select bands in:

FM1 > FM2 > FM3 > AM1 > AM2 > Fm1

ST/MONO Selector:

In the RADIO mode, you can press ST button to select MONO mode or STEREO mode.

AST:

In the RADIO mode, press the AST button to scan each stored station. Press the corresponding preset or AST button when your desired station is playing.

Number Buttons:

Press and hold any preset 1-6 to stored your favorite radio stations, remember, you have 18 FM and 12 AM stations to store.

LQC:

In RADIO mode, press this button twice to enter the radio setup page; for "LOCAL" item, use LEFT/RIGHT (4/) to switch LOC function on/off.

Direction:

In the RADIO mode:

press the button to adjust frequency forward or backward step by step. Press the LEFT or RIGHT direction buttons to scanto the next strongest station.

You can also use the UP or DOWN direction buttons to scan to the next strongest station.

SETUP OF PLAYER FUNCTION

Setup Menu Description

Press Setup button to enter Selup Menu.

Use UP/DOWN and LEFT/RIGHT arrow buttons to select the items you want to change.

Press Enter buttons to make sure the item you have selected.

After finishing your settings, you can press Setup to exit and save these Modifications.

Note: This part takes effect only in DVD mode.
